**TACOMA, WASH.** – The internationally acclaimed Vienna Boys Choir will perform at Tacoma's Pantages Theater on Sunday, November 13 at 3:00 p.m. Dressed in their trademark sailor suits and shiny black shoes, they'll perform Austrian folk songs, classical masterpieces, and beloved pop songs. [The Vienna Boys Choir](#) is a choir of sopranos and altos based in Vienna, Austria. Known as one of the best boys' choirs in the world, there are one hundred choristers from thirty different nations between the ages of ten and fourteen years old on tour.

The Vienna Boys Choir has been singing at Vienna's Imperial Chapel since 1296. In 1498, Maximilian I moved his court to Vienna and instructed there were to be six singing boys among his musicians. This began the foundation of what is known today as the Vienna Boys Choir. Over the centuries, the Viennese Court attracted musicians like Mozart, Salieri, and Bruckner; Joseph Haydn, Michael Haydn, and Franz Schubert were themselves choristers.

The Chapel Imperial always traveled with the Emperor. Today, touring is part of the chorister's education. Since 1926, the Vienna Boys Choir has undertaken more than 1,000 tours in 97 different countries; in that time, the boys have sung more than 27,000 concerts.
