Summer Camp COVID Policy

Theater, singing, and dancing require students to be in close proximity to one another for extended periods and to breathe deeply. Because of this, our camp COVID policy is as follows:

- Staff and interns are required to be vaccinated and masked.
- Campers must be vaccinated or provide a negative home test twice weekly (on Mondays and Wednesdays).

 - Tacoma Arts Live is working to secure additional home tests that we can provide to families as needed.
- Masks are required during camp, with the exception of
 - While eating or drinking
 - While onstage for dress rehearsals and performances. When campers exit the stage, masks are to be put back on.
- If a student prefers to remain masked during performance, Tacoma Arts Live will provide a mask that matches their costume.

Please note, all COVID policies are subject to revision based on community transmission and case rates.
